

ABC Crowdsourcing Collection Statement

The ABC takes your privacy seriously and is committed to protecting your personal information in accordance with the ABC Editorial Policies.

When you complete one of these online forms, we collect basic personal information such as your name, age, postcode and gender. We may also collect contact details such as your email address and telephone number, as well as the specific information that you provide in response to our inquiries.

Some of the information we collect about you may be sensitive information, including information about your political affiliations, religious beliefs, physical or mental health or sexuality. In providing this information, you consent to us collecting sensitive information which you provide to us voluntarily. Your identity will be treated as strictly confidential by the ABC, unless otherwise agreed with you, and any sensitive information you provide to us will not be published without your express permission.

You don't have to give us all the information we ask you to provide, but this may limit how we interact with you, and the extent of your involvement in our investigation.

The information we collect is used to:

- prepare and present ABC programs and content;
- investigate matters of public interest;
- contact you as part of our investigation; and
- manage our relationship with you, including providing you with updates about our investigation (if you opt in to receive them).

We are currently using a third-party platform, Screendoor, to collect information during crowdsourced investigations. Screendoor is a product of Citybase LLC, whose servers are located in the USA.
